INTRODUCTION

Jesus expands his theme of 'abiding' – remaining continually – in God's love. Abiding follows keeping his commandment: that we love one another as he loves us. He explains that the greatest expression of love is that which lays down life for a friend. The evangelist, writing after the death and resurrection of Jesus, lets this passage resonate with what readers know, through the cross, of the depth of God's sacrificial love for the world. As disciples today, whether or not we are called to lay down our lives, the commandment to love and abide holds for us too.
